ETIQUETTE POLICY

As a public library, our purpose is to provide a safe and confidential environment in which users may freely pursue intellectual interests. Any conduct or activity that adversely impacts this purpose is prohibited, including but not limited to: loud talking, cell phone use, or interrupting other patrons while using the public computer stations.

Smoking is not allowed anywhere in the library, including the bathrooms and no nearer the front door than the parking area.

Users are prohibited from damaging or defacing the library building or property including materials in the various collections. Unauthorized removal of these materials is likewise prohibited.

Librarians and staff are charged with enforcing this policy. They may, at their discretion, request assistance from the city police.
