

How to Get a Card

To obtain a card you must show a current government, work or school issued picture ID and proof of address. Acceptable forms of picture identification include driver's license, school ID, military ID or passport. Acceptable forms of proof of address include driver's license, voter registration or mail that has been received to the patron's residence. There is no charge for a library card.

Library cards may be issued to individuals 8 years or older. Applicants 17 years and under must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian when requesting membership.

Borrowing limits:

Materials may be checked out for two weeks, with renewal privilege, (in person, by phone, or from the website), unless there are reserves on the items.

Materials may be checked out for longer periods of time for members who are traveling or homebound.

DVD's are checked out for seven days.
